Quickstart Tennis:

Mon. Thur: 8:00–8:45 or 8:45–9:30 am
\$40/week or \$250/12 week pass

QuickStart Tennis is the new way to play for kids 10 and under. Utilizing adapted equipment and age-appropriate court dimensions, QuickStart ensures a safe and positive first time tennis experience enabling children to play tennis almost immediately. Ideal for children ages 4–10.

Tournament Development Academy:

Monday–Thursday 9:30–11:30 am
\$75/week or \$450/12 week pass

For players with some tournament experience but that are not quite at the elite level yet. Ideal for those wishing to take their game to the next level and advance to National Academy program. The emphasis is on technique refinement and strategy. Ages 8–18.

Intermediate Development Academy Group

Monday – Thursday 1:00–4:00 pm
\$100/week or \$600/12 week pass

Academy program for the player that is not quite to the elite tournament level. Players will drill and refine technique to advance to the National Academy level. Strategies (including directionals) will be covered on a daily basis. This is the group to get you ready for a high state, Southern and national level. Ages 8–18.

This program will take your game to the elite level. Players will be competing regularly at the Southern and National level. Participants are expected to come ready to train and work hard on a daily basis. If you want to compete with the best in the country then this is your group! The emphasis is on technique and match strategy in the morning (9:00 to 11:30 am), supervised lunch break (11:30 to 1:00 pm) and match play and conditioning in the afternoon (1:00 pm to 4:00 pm). These weekly camps will be the training ground to improve your game and prepare for the competitive summer tournament schedule. Ages 8–18.
