Several RPTA Students Shine in Summer Competition

Kayla Duncan Wins National Title

Kayla Duncan, RPTA player, freshman at Texas Christian University, and former Reynolds player won the Girl's 18 & Under National Clay Court Doubles Championship in Memphis, TN.
